




## • **Pentagon -** 22 Malczewskiego Street








# Room layout in "Pentagon "

# A few tips...

- **Parking** there are few parking spaces near the buildings of the Faculty of Philology and Pedagogy, so we encourage you to use public transport.
- **Tutor of the year** check the WFP website to find out who your year supervisor is. This is the person who will help you take your first steps at the university and support you throughout your studies.
- **Students` room** the Pentagon building has a place where you can spend your free time.
- Cafeteria we do not have a cafeteria, but you can eat something warm in Galeria Słoneczna, which is adjacent to our faculty.
- **Vending machines** both in the Pentagon and Olimp buildings, you will find vending machines with hot drinks and snacks.





## University etiquette...

# During your studies, you should address lecturers according to their title or academic degree:

- Professor, Doctor, Master.
- A person with a postdoctoral degree (dr hab.) should be addressed as Professor.
- Functional persons should be addressed as follows:
  - o Rector Rector, Vice-Rector, Dean, Vice-Dean.

#### It is best to start an email with the following phrase:

- Dear Professor/Doctor/Master, and end with: Sincerely/ With respect and signature (first name, last name, field of study, and year of study).
- Work email addresses for employees: **first letter of first name.last name without Polish letters@urad.edu.pl** e.g., a.nowak@urad.edu.pl

#### Remember:

- Be punctual! If you are late, try to enter the room discreetly (only use the student quarter of an hour in exceptional circumstances).
- Turn off or mute your phone before class.
- Do not talk during class unless the lecturer initiates a discussion.
- Listen carefully and take notes during class. Do not take photos of materials presented by the lecturer without their prior consent.

## Glossary...

**Rector's day or hours** - a day or selected hours when classes are not held and do not need to be made up.

**Test** - assessment of the student's knowledge.

Language classes - classes in foreign languages chosen by the student.

**Rector** - the most important person at the university, who manages it.

**Vice-rector** - replaces the rector and is responsible for a certain range of tasks, e.g. matters concerning students.

**Dean** - the person in charge of a faculty.

**Supervisor** - an academic teacher chosen by the student, entrusted by the dean with conducting a diploma seminar.

**Tutor of the year** - university employees who support a designated group of students during their studies.

**Class representative** - a representative of the group who, on behalf of the other students, liaises with lecturers on behalf of the other students.

**ECTS credits** - credits awarded for passing a course; used in the European Higher Education Area, they allow students to continue or undertake studies at other European universities.

**Exam session** – the period during which subject exams are taken.

**Lecture -** consists of the presentation of content by the lecturer. The task of the students is to absorb the information and take notes.

**Exercises** - their purpose is to expand on the topics covered in lectures. They are held in small groups, allowing students to put their knowledge into practice (e.g., during discussions).

**Seminar -** this involves discussion between the lecturer and students and joint problem-solving of theoretical and practical issues. It takes place in small groups.

**Specialization** - narrowing the educational path to professional interests in which the student feels comfortable and wants to work.

**Syllabus** - a description of the course, including educational objectives, learning outcomes, conditions for passing, curriculum content, and literature.

**Resit session** - if a student fails a course on the first or second attempt, they have the right to apply for a resit during the resit exam session.
